Coach Service Terms and Conditions

Bookings and payment

Coach places should be booked for an academic year at the start of that year. The charge will be added to your bill at the end of each term.

Refunds for journeys booked but not used will only be given if it is a consequence of the school's actions.

Notice to stop using the service / amendments must be received in writing one full half term in advance of the change. If insufficient notice is received a full half term's charges will be payable.

Operational

Seat belts must be worn at all times.

Pupils must not consume any food or drink on the coaches.

To keep scheduled journey times to an absolute minimum, drivers will not wait for late-comers.

Pupils may not use the coach for any journeys unless they have a valid pass.

Pupils may not use the coach to take to or bring home from School anyone who does not in themselves have permission to travel.

Pupils found to be travelling without a valid pass are liable to a £10 fine on each occasion.

Please do not try and enter into private agreements with the drivers in respect of setting down and picking up points as this puts them in an unnecessarily awkward position when they are obliged to refuse.

In the event of missing the coach home pupils should inform the school office and make arrangements to be collected.

The School reserves the right to modify all routes and alter the terms and conditions of the service.

If any parent or pupil has any concerns about the service they should notify the Bursar in the first instance.
