

TEACHING AND LEARNING

Development in this area is essential to ensure that all girls have the opportunities they need to develop to their potential.

In recent years we have:

- Reviewed our provision in terms of courses and subjects for public examinations. We have introduced Psychology and Further Mathematics at A level
- Reviewed our provision in the early years to include violin tuition as an integral part of the curriculum
- Abandoned Key Stage Two SATs which were having a restricting effect on the curriculum in the Preparatory Department
- Appointed a Learning Support Co-ordinator
- Introduced study skills lessons into Years 8 and 9

In the next three years we will:

- Continually review our provision in terms of courses and subjects offered for public examinations
- Improve links between the Infant, Preparatory and Senior Departments of the school across all curriculum areas
- Review and extend as appropriate study skills teaching
- Improve the co-ordination of the PSHE programme in the Senior Department under the leadership of a member of the Senior Management Team
- Review our provision in the early years to include more learning through play without affecting high academic standards
- Promote independent learning across the school
